

How do I turn off the red and green lines under my words in Word?

The red and green lines in Word are automatic spelling and grammar checking tools that are active when you first start Word. Red underlines are for words that are either misspelled or words that the program does not recognize. Green underlines indicate a problem with grammar.

To turn them on or off, on the Tools menu, click Options, and then click the Spelling & Grammar tab.

Do one or both of the following:

- To turn on or off automatic spelling checking, select or clear the Check spelling as you type check box.
- To turn on or off automatic grammar checking, select or clear the Check grammar as you type check box.
