# APPLYING TO MEREDITH

# What you need to know

#### Introduction:

- Apply as a Transfer Student if you are 22 years of age or younger and enrolled in a community or fouryear college following high school graduation and have a part-time or full-time enrollment record.
- Apply as a Wings Adult Education
  First Degree student if you are 23
  years of age or older and have
  never enrolled in college after
  graduating from high school or
  earning a general equivalency
  high school diploma.
- Apply as a Wings Adult Education
  Degree Completion student if you
  are 23 or older and have enrolled in
  a community or four-year college or
  university since graduating from high
  school.
- Apply as a Wings Second Degree student if you have previously earned a bachelors degree or will have earned a a bachelors degree before enrolling at Meredith.

# Transfer/Adult Undergraduate Students

#### Priority Application Dates: Fall semester — February 15 Spring semester — November 1 Summer semester — March 1

\*Applications submitted after these dates will be considered for admission as space allows.

The Office of Admissions receives spring and fall entry applications beginning on August 1 of each year. Admission decisions are offered on a rolling basis after all application credentials have been received.

#### Requirements

#### **Transfer Applicants**

To be considered for admission, the applicant must:

- Be 22 years of age or younger at time of enrollment,
- Have 30 or more hours of transferrable college coursework with at least 18 hours that meet General Education requirements,
- Have a C or higher in a college transferable math class at an accredited institution, or have completed Algebra I, II (or their equivalents) and Geometry in high school,
- Have a minimum overall C average on all courses attempted at postsecondary institutions,
- Be eligible to return to the last institution regularly attended in good standing and be recommended by college officials.

Applicants with fewer than 30 transferrable credits at the time of application must meet freshman application requirements including submission of official high school transcript(s). Submission of the SAT or ACT is optional

Applicants with more than 30 transferrable credits at the time of application but less than 18 transferrable General Education credits may be asked to meet freshman admission requirements before an admission decision is offered.

# Wings – Adult Education First Degree

To be considered for admission, the applicant must:

- Be 23 years of age or older, at time of enrollment.
- Have graduated from high school or earned a high school general equivalency diploma,
- Have passed Algebra I, II, and Geometry, or equivalent in high school with at least a C.

Students not meeting the mathematics requirement will meet with the Director of Wings to help develop an individualized college mathematics preparation plan.

# Wings – Adult Education Degree Completion

To be considered for admission, the applicant must:

- Be 23 years of age or older, at time of enrollment.
- Have enrolled in a two-year or four-year institution after high school graduation or earning a general, equivalency high school diploma,
- Have a C or higher in a college transferrable math class at an accredited institution, or have completed Algebra I, II (or their equivalents) and Geometry in high school,

Students not meeting the mathematics requirement will meet with the Director of Wings to help develop an individualized college mathematics preparation plan.

# Wings – Adult Education Second Degree

Students who wish to seek a second degree must have completed their first baccalaureate degree prior to enrollment.

#### Admissions Procedures

A complete application for transfer admission includes:

- Completed and signed application form, including essay,
- \$40 non-refundable application fee or acceptable fee waiver,
- Official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended whether or not credit was earned.
- School Report School Official Recommendation from college last attended,
- Professor recommendation (optional).

Transfer students with fewer than 30 transferrable hours must also submit a high school transcript or general equivalency diploma and SAT or ACT scores (test scores are optional).

Non-native English speakers must submit scores from the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS).

#### A complete application for WINGS – Adult Education Degree Completion includes:

- Completed and signed application form, including essay,
- \$40 non-refundable application fee or acceptable fee waiver,
- Official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended whether or not credit was earned,
- School Report School Official Recommendation from college last attended.
- Professor recommendation (optional),

Degree completion students with fewer than 30 transferrable hours must also submit a high school transcript or general equivalency diploma, and interview with the Director of Wings.

# A complete application for WINGS – Adult Education Second Degree admission includes:

- Completed and signed application form, including essay,
- \$40 non-refundable application fee or acceptable fee waiver,

- Official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended whether or not credit was earned.
- School Report School Official Recommendation from college last attended if enrolled since receiving first degree,
- Professor recommendation (optional).

#### **Financial Aid**

Meredith requires the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for all applicants who wish to receive financial assistance. The priority deadline is February 15. Applications received after this date will be considered for assistance as funding permits. The FAFSA is available beginning October 1 at FAFSA.ed.gov.

At Meredith College, we recognize and reward outstanding ability and talent by sponsoring competitive scholarship programs. At the time of admissions to Meredith as a transfer student, you will be automatically considered for an Academic Incentive Scholarship. All other scholarships and scholars programs require a separate application.
